USA BRIDGEPORT



Bridgeport waste heat from incineration plant to district heating

Total project sum 180 mio DKK

Partnership: ABB, Logstor, Damgaard, Niras, Danfoss, DESMI, Oe3i, Kamstrup

Status: Exclusive agreement signed



CHINA DESK






FIGURE 1: Proportion of actions started vs. those not yet started SOURCE: C40 City Potential for Climate Action 2015







FIGURE 2: Frequency with which private sector Technology and Infrastructure challenges are linked with each stage in the project delivery cycle, across regions
