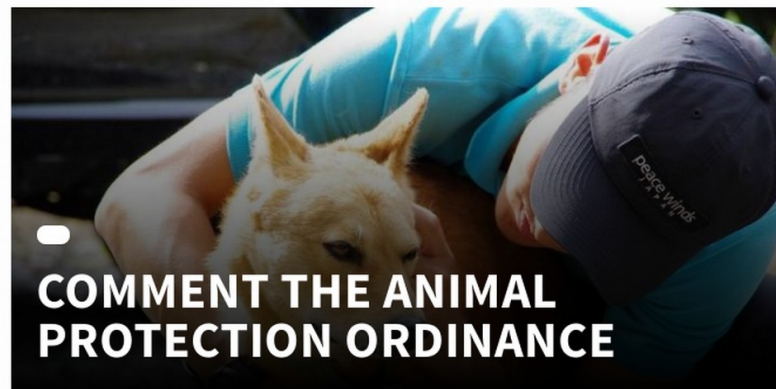
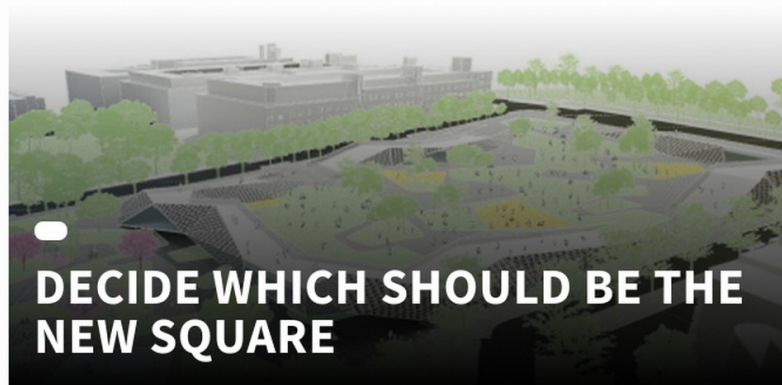

# Madrid - 100% Sustainable

We want a Madrid that does not wake up with a gray pollution beret, that defies electricity, boosts renewables and makes sure that no family is cut off this winter.

How?

Asking the City Council of Madrid to commit to **sign the manifesto "MADRID SUSTAINABLE CITY" and start it up** - We demand compliance with the following 14 points:

1. Develop awareness campaigns, training and **promotion of energy culture** in all areas of the city.
2. Hire **municipal electricity with a 100% renewable guarantee of origin**.
3. Establish a transversal work team for the **elaboration, execution and monitoring of strategic plans**.
4. Facilitate the regular obtaining of the **energy and economic data** necessary for its management.
5. **Design and implement energy efficiency actions in municipal facilities**, prioritizing changes in habits to eliminate waste in consumption. The savings achieved by changing habits will be invested, in part or in full, in new energy efficiency measures.
6. **Implement energy efficiency programs in schools**, such as the 50/50 project - consisting of returning 50% of the savings to the school and reverting the other half into new savings, efficiency and renewable measures in the same center.
7. **Apply measures to combat energy poverty**: processing of the social bond, etc.
8. Design and execute all **new municipal constructions or works with almost zero energy consumption criteria**.
9. **Implement sustainable mobility actions**: promotion of public transport, use of sustainable vehicles, street pedestrianization, etc.
10. Design a plan to gradually replace the entire mobile park dedicated to public transport and municipal **vehicles with electric** vehicles.
11. Establish **fiscal measures to promote energy efficiency** and renewable energy.
12. Review municipal ordinances to **favor energy self-supply systems** based on renewable energy.
13. Generate a **sustainable urban model by stopping speculative processes**.
14. **Make a sustainable management of Urban Solid Waste**.

# Air Quality and Climate Change Plan

## DESCRIPTION

One of the main responsibilities of city councils is to look after the health of their citizens, implementing actions aimed at reducing risk situations and, among them, preventing climate change and monitoring and improving the quality of the air we breathe.

The reduction of air pollution and the fight against climate change must not be delayed, given that air pollution in cities is already the fourth cause of premature death in the world, according to a report published by the World Bank last September, and that cities are also important emitters of greenhouse gases.

In the City Council we are working so that next year we have an Air Quality and Climate Change Plan that responds to these needs. Right now we are defining thirty proposals in collaboration with neighbourhood and social organisations, technicians, administrations, academic institutions, social and trade associations and collectives, trade unions, business organisations and political groups. At the same time, we want our neighbours to be able to get to know them.

Now is the time for you to tell us here how you think these measures would work in your street, in your neighbourhood, in your district.

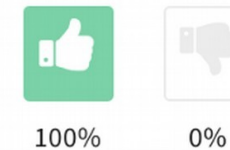

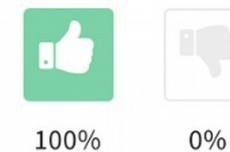

# Ordinance regulating the holding and protection of animals.



## TEXT

## COMMENTS

## TITLE I GENERAL PROVISIONS

### Article 1: Subject matter and scope

The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish those requirements that may be demanded in the municipality, for the keeping of pets, and also those used for **lucrative purposes, sports and recreation**, in order to achieve, on the one hand, the proper conditions of health and safety for the environment and, on the other, adequate protection of animals.

### Article 2: Regulatory framework

The holding and protection of animals in the municipality of Madrid shall be subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, as well as the Epizootics Law of 20 December 1952, Law 1/1990 on the Protection of Animals, and Law 1/1990 on the Protection of Animals.

Domestic Animals, the **Law 2/1991** of Protection of the Fauna and Wild Flora of the Community, and other regulations that can be for him of application.

### Article 3: Definitions

1. Pet: is maintained by man, mainly in his home, for pleasure and pleasure. company, without constituting the object of any lucrative activity.
2. Domestic animal of exploitation: it is the one that, adapted to the human environment, is maintained by the man. for profit or otherwise, and may in no case constitute a danger to persons or property.
3. **Wild pet animal: is that belonging to the native or foreign fauna, which has required a period of adaptation to the human environment and that is maintained by man, mainly in his home, by the pleasure and company, without being the object of any lucrative activity.**

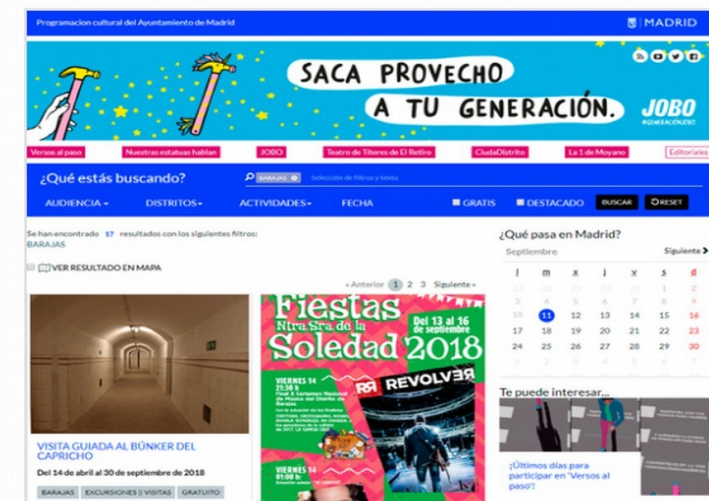

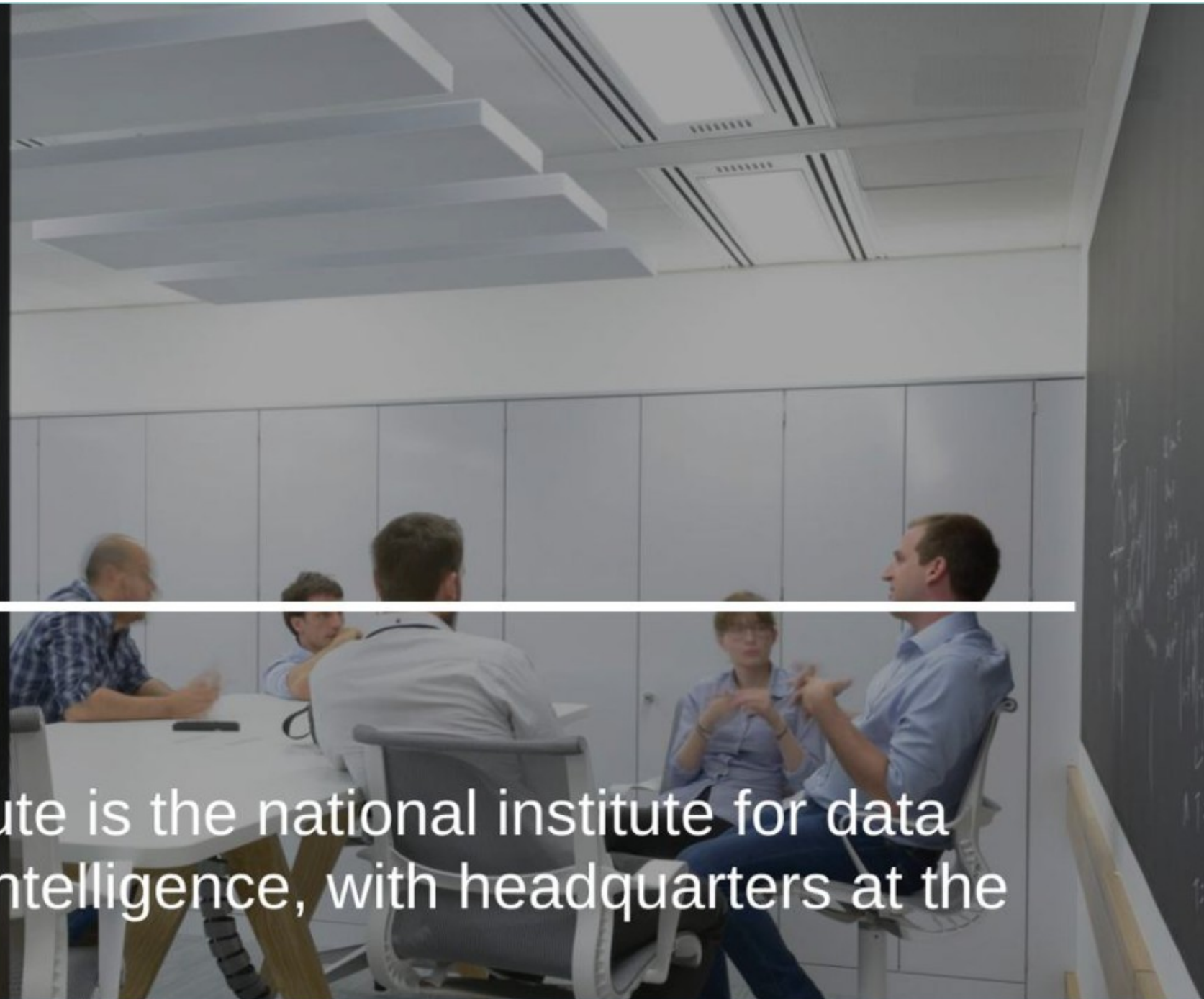
