





A smart modernisation and eco-innovative approach in port management has become key to allow port authorities to cope with ever growing multifaced challenges and make a step forward, by moving toward a more advanced, environmentally friendly future.

THE NON-STOP PROJECT AIMS TO IMPLEMENT A GREEN SMART DIGITAL TRANSITION IN THE MANAGEMENT OF NSR'S PORTS OF REGIONAL IMPORTANCE. THIS WILL BE ACHIEVED BY INTRODUCING, TESTING AND MONITORING INTELLIGENT TECHNOLOGIES AND PROCESSES IN THE STORAGE, DEPLOYMENT, SHARING AND TRANSMISSION OF DATA RELATED TO MARINE CONDITIONS, SEA/LANDSIDE OPERATIONS AND ENERGY PRODUCTION/CONSUMPTION/DISTRIBUTION IN PORTS.

The ultimate goal is to reduce by 10% the time of pre-defined logistical/maintenance port operations

and lower by 10% the port energy and pollution by building on collaborative expertise and joint practice.
