

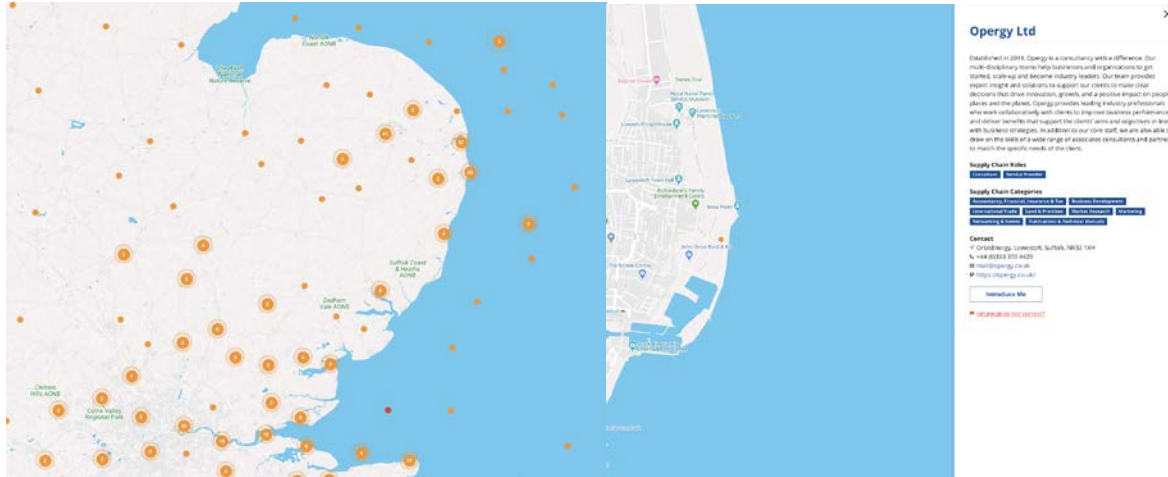
## GUIDE

### 1. Accessing the platform and searching for companies via the interactive map



To start using the Company Directory, just go to - <http://www.inn2power.eu/mapping>. Registration isn't required to access it and it's completely free to use. When you enter the platform, you'll see an interactive map which can be navigated using your mouse.

Each location displays a number, which can be clicked on to zoom in further to the map - so if you want to look at businesses in a specific location, this is a good place to start. Once you zoom in a couple of times, you will see circles for individual businesses, which can be clicked to display information on a company. This information includes a bio, supply chain roles, supply chain categories, contact details and the **'Introduce Me'** button (please see section **3. The 'Introduce Me' system**).



## 2. Searching for companies by Capabilities and Keywords.



If you're looking for companies based on their supply chain role (such as operator) or supply chain category (for example, decommissioning and abandonment) you can click on the orange tick box button positioned at the right-hand sidebar.

This will reveal a filter menu, with a number of options. By ticking various boxes, the main map will adjust the number of companies displayed based on your preferences.

Follow the same steps detailed above in section **1. Accessing the platform and searching for companies via the interactive map** to zoom into the map and find specific companies. We've also added a handy **Reset Filter** button in the top right corner, to remove any of the ticks from the checkboxes, returning the number of companies displayed back to the default.
