A list of some of the current challenges are listed below:

The Shop Window has seven aspirations goals, which are:

Zero pollutions and flooding

Examples of how you could help include:

- Real time control of all sewerage assets within the catchment
- Changing customer behaviour (Keep it clear, diffuse pollution) using social media
- Collaboration of multi-agency stakeholders, to access information about the catchment, including surface water management and Integrated drainage plans

100% compliant and chemical free drinking water

Examples of how you could help include:

- Zero dosage of Orthophosphoric acid
- Eliminating customer derived water quality issues
- Ensuring 100% integrity of all assets post disinfection

Energy Neutral

Examples of how you could help include:

- Cambridge Treatment works transformed into an Energy Factory
- Dynamic discharge consenting of Water Recycling works
- Reducing diurnal demand on water and sewerage network

Zero leakage and no bursts

Examples of how you could help include:

- Development of a predictive Leak and Burst model
- Horizon scan and Scoping for self-healing intelligent Networks
- Improving standards for new assets (better materials, techniques, processes etc.)

80 litres per head per day

Examples of how you could help include:

- Develop a water foot printing model for the shop window catchment
- Implementation of smart metering in the shop window
- Development of a customer engagement strategy to further promote water efficiency

100% Customer satisfaction

Examples of how you could help include:

- Using Smart Meters as communication channel for multiple applications
- Development of community hubs and advocates to better understand our customers and influence behaviour

Build a circular economy

Examples of how you could help include:

- Create innovative ways to reduce and reuse waste
- Release greater values from process losses and treatment by-product
- Operate to rejuvenate the natural resource
