## Multi-annual Financial Framework 2021-2027

- Overall communication and framework published by the European Commission 02.05.2018
  - Proposal 1135 bEUR.
  - Focus on R&I, youth, migration and defense.
  - Cuts to agriculture and cohesion policy.
- Individual sectoral programme proposals published
  - Cohesion 29.05.2018
  - Connecting Europe Facility 06.06.2018



## Multi-annual Financial Framework 2021-2027

- Impact of Brexit on future UK involvement in individual programmes remains unclear. Will the UK stay involved as a third country or not (cfr. Norway)?
- Discussion on MFF sectoral programme proposals to start under Austrian EU Presidency as of July 2018.
- Ambition to reach an agreement before the European elections in May 2019.



# **Cohesion policy - proposal**

- Proposal 373 bEUR
- Cross-border co-operation to focus on land borders, cross-border co-operation on maritime borders to be integrated into transnational co-operation.
- No proposals yet on borders of individual programmes, nor individual programme envelopes.

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#### **Policy objectives**

11 objectives are simplified and consolidated to 5:

- 1. A smarter Europe (innovative & smart economic transformation)
- 2. A greener, low-carbon Europe (including energy transition, the circular economy, climate adaptation and risk management)
- 3. A more connected Europe (mobility and ICT connectivity)
- 4. A more social Europe (the European Pillar of Social Rights)
- 5. A Europe closer to citizens (sustainable development of urban, rural and coastal areas and local initiatives)

Horizontal issues: administrative capacity building, cooperation outside the programme area





# **Cohesion policy - proposal**

- 5 policy objectives for all programmes.
- PO 3 "A more connected Europe (mobility and ICT connectivity)"
- Possible fields of intervention for mobility: TEN-T network, digitalisation of transport, clean urban transport, alternative fuels, multimodal transport, inland waterways and ports, ...



- Proposal 30,6 bEUR
  - 12,8 bEUR general envelope
  - 11,3 bEUR cohesion envelope
  - 6,5 bEUR military mobility / dual use

## • Two policy objectives

- Infrastructure "Efficient and interconnected networks"
  60% of funds
- Horizontal "Smart, sustainable, inclusive, safe and secure mobility" – 40% of funds



- Most of the funds for the policy objective on infrastructure will go to the Core Network Corridors.
- List of pre-identified projects in annex to the proposal. Focus on cross-border projects.
- General envelope: only two cofinancing rates remain: 30% (default) and 50%. The latter for cross-border projects, telematics, new technologies and innovation, infrastructure safety and projects in outermost regions.



- Innovative financing instruments no longer in CEF 2, but regrouped in the new overall "InvestEU" instrument.
- Concertation and synergies with other funding programmes encouraged, in particular Horizon Europe and ERDF/ETC.



- Relevant changes to the Core Network Corridors, in particular to CNC Scandinavia – Mediterranean.
  - Inclusion of additional German and Danish sections to the corridor.
  - Kiel Canal in Germany.
  - North Jutland in Denmark.
