Greenhouse gas emissions in Västra Götaland should be reduced by **80 percent** (compared with levels in 1990).



Greenhouse gas emissions caused by the consumption of the residents of western Sweden, no matter where in the world they occur, should be reduced by **30 percent** (compared with levels 2010).








